

TAKE A PEEK INTO SOME OF OUR CLASSROOMS!




We have been working so hard to learn our letter sounds and apply them to writing sentences!

MR. PARSONS

We have been busy so far in our Social Skills, Mindfulness & Yoga class! So far in Social Skills, we have mastered our Skills for Learning (Listening, Focusing, using Self-talk, and Being Assertive). We are now developing our Empathy by being Feelings Detectives. We learned to look for clues about how people are feeling by looking at people's faces and bodies and by paying attention to what is happening around them.

In Yoga & Mindfulness, we practice the 3 B's every day (Body, Breath, Brain) so we can do our best to try new Yoga poses! We move our bodies in new ways, we practice new breathing techniques, and have mindful meditation exercises. We have lots of fun together every day! MR. 
Here is one group practicing their Monkey Arms! We practice this yoga pose often and see how we improve as our fingers get closer and closer together.



Here is a class doing a modified Star Pose. After mastering Star Pose, we made our stars twinkle by moving and breathing together.



Here is a classroom full of trees! We learned that we can change Tree Pose to make it challenging. We also created our own trees by moving our "branches" and "roots" in different ways.



In Social Skills, we use books to reinforce what we learn. Jabari Jumps helped remind us how we can use self-talk to help us be brave when we try something new or scary. World Down Syndrome Day was on March 21st! This day was created to celebrate the lives of people with Down Syndrome and to make sure they have the same freedoms and opportunities as everybody else. PAELC students joined in this celebration by wearing brightly colored, mismatched socks.
