Students outside enjoying the beautiful weather at recess. Mrs. West's class loves to use sidewalk chalk, play tag, and have races during recess!




Students painting Kindness Rocks. They are looking forward to finding their rocks out in the community.


I love teaching and working with children, especially K-5!
